**Psalm 139 BASICS**

- Author: King David
- Genre: Revelation & Vindication Psalm
- Subject: Significance of God & His People
- Title: To the choirmaster. A Psalm of David. (part of collection of songs for temple worship)
- A personal prayer (“I & You” pronouns)
- “The Crown of Psalms” “A Devotional Classic” “A Tribute to the Greatness of God”

**OUTLINE**

- vs.1-6 God knows everything about me
- vs.7-12: God is everywhere I am all the time
- vs.13-18: God created me wonderfully
- vs.19-22: God, take action against our enemies
- vs. 23-24: God examine me and know my heart

**PART 1: God knows \_\_\_\_\_ about you (vs.1-4)**

**PART 2: God \_\_\_\_\_ about you (vs.5-6,10)**

**Q: How well does God know you and care for you?**

**A: TOTALLY & COMPLETELY**

**The ONE who knows you best loves you most!**

**PART 3: God is \_\_\_\_\_ you are (vs.7-12)**

Interpretative Problem: “If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there” (v.8)

Depths: Sheol-the place of the dead or HELL

**PART 4: God created you for a \_\_\_\_\_ (vs.13-18)**

(see Jeremiah 29:11-14 & John 9:1-41)

“We are God’s Masterpiece! God created us to belong to Jesus Christ so we can do good works He already has planned for us” (Ephesians 2:10)

**PART 5: God is \_\_\_\_\_ for you (vs. 19-22)**

God, slay the wicked! Away from me, you who are bloodthirsty! (v.19)

WHY?

1. David wants God to know he’s on God’s side
2. David understood that God has the power to destroy evil

**PART 6: Personal Examination (vs.23-24)**

Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you and lead me along the path of everlasting life.

**The Bridge to Jesus : The ULTIMATE Proof of Your Significance**

God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.(Romans 5:8)

**You are so incredibly significant to God that He died for you.  
God paid the highest price possible for you!**

**YOU are Significant to the ONE who Matters Most!  
(Psalm 139: we are Super Important to God)**
